Public works this month has recently been working on many smaller housing projects, this consisted mainly of getting units that were moved out of repaired and ready to rent again. We have completed four units and continue to work on more in both Opitsaht and Tyhistanis.

The container Housing Project has reached 75% completion. Most of the homes there have reached the lock up, drywall and finishes stages. There is also a sanitary lift station that will be install this coming month on the site. Many of the personal in our department spent time with the search efforts that took place for our lost members of the community.



We are currently working along with Nuuchahnulth Tribal council in the development of Cityworks computer program. This will help with all the asset tracking and work orders that flow through the Public Works Department. It will allow the department to better operate in the near future and be more accountable of time and assets.

The Renovation projects have now started, and the Public works team have started with a vacant dwelling in Esowista that will require extensive work. This will consist of rot repair, siding, insulation, roof, framing, drywall and install of many finishes.
